

Stanford on iTunes

Frequently Asked Questions (and Answers)

What if I have Windows? Can I still install iTunes?

Yes. Apple has a Windows 2000/XP version of iTunes available for free download off their website <http://www.apple.com/itunes>.

Is Stanford on iTunes part of the iTunes Music Store?

No. The tracks offered in Stanford on iTunes are kept apart from the content on the main iTunes Music Store. Thus, you will not be able to access Stanford on iTunes directly without first visiting itunes.stanford.edu.

Will I have to pay to access the Stanford on iTunes?

No. You may freely preview and download all of the content from Stanford on iTunes.

The search is not returning many Stanford tracks. Is there something wrong?

The search function currently references the main iTunes Music Store. Stanford on iTunes tracks are catalogued separately, and thus will not be found in a search at the moment.

Can I access Stanford on iTunes directly without first opening a browser?

No. Since this is a special section for Stanford, there are no direct links off of the main iTunes Music Store. You must first visit itunes.stanford.edu to access Stanford on iTunes.

I can see other people's playlist in my iTunes. Did someone hack into my computer?

No. iTunes features the ability to stream other people's music from their playlists. You may not, however, transfer these files to your computer.

Can I connect my iPod to other people's computers and download their music?

No. Your iPod can only synch with one music library at a time. So unless you would like to completely reformat your iPod to synch to another computer, it cannot be done.

Will I be able to use other mp3 players with iTunes?

Yes and no. There is moderate support in iTunes for some 3rd Party players, but they will not be able to play AAC files (including songs from the iTunes Music Store). Apple offers a full line of iPod products and accessories which will give you the best digital experience.
